LOWLANDS

The Lowlands, defined by an imaginary line from Greenock in the west to Dundee in the east, are among the most delicately flavoured malts in Scotland. A superb Aperitif before any meal whilst the Auchentoshan 3 Wood is a great foil for a cigar.

Nose: Powerful smoky sourness

Palate: Fresh, clean with well balanced sweetness

Glenmorangie (10 years) J

Nose: Medium weight, hints of butterscotch, mandarin, orange and vanilla

Palate: Flowery fruitiness and vanilla sweetness

Finish: Creamy, soft and fresh

Dalwhinnie (15 years) C

Nose: Aromatic, medium sweet with a light peatiness

Palate: Remarkably smooth, long lasting flavour. Honey, grass, vanilla and malt

Finish: Very long

Glen Garioch (21 years) A

Nose: Unique mix of peat and sherry

Palate: Slightly peaty with silky feel

Finish: Elegant and impressive

Speyside is the “Capital” of the Scottish Malt Whisky producing regions, taking in a diverse selection of flavours from the heavily sherried to the light and fruity.

Macallan Fine Oak (15 years) C

Nose: Unique blend of bananas and spring grass with strong floral hint

Palate: Brown sugar sweetness of the malt, tempered by drier vanilla

Finish: Ongoing rich barley theme punctuated with peaty spice, and late butterscotch/toffee aftertaste

Glenrothes (1979) A

Nose: Complex grainy nose with bite

Palate: Fresh, clean with hint of honey

Finish: Grainy crispness with soft floating smokiness

ISLAY

Islay is the greatest of the whisky islands. Deep in peat, lashed by rain, wind and sea. The single malts from Islay are considered to be the most expressive of all Scottish Malts.

Caol Ila (12 year) J

Nose: Fresh sea-air aromas only revealing smokiness shortly after. Adding water seems to bring out beach bonfire

Palate: Sweet to start. Unmistakably Islay, agreeably pungent but not too heavy

Finish: Lingering, charred-dry

Ardbeg Uigeadail C

Nose: Awesome package of massive oak, intense peat and leather notes

Palate: Bitter-sweet oaky notes with fruity peat entry

Finish: Surprising finish with off key fruit element

THE ISLANDS

The Orkney Isles play host to the two most northerly distilleries in Scotland. The Isle of Skye is the home of the hedonistic and volcanic Talisker. The Isle of Arran, (Scotland's youngest distillery), Jura and Mull are all off the West Coast of Scotland.

Talisker (10 years) J

Nose: Powerful peat-smoke with seawater saltiness and a citrus touch

Palate: Strange addition of toffee at the start

Finish: Big peat explosion held back by caramel flavours

Scapa (14 years) C

Nose: Honeydew melon, soft salt and myriad styles of barley

Palate: A complex display of malt and cocoa, mixed with ripe figs and a thread of honey

Finish: Slight bitterness with developing toffee

Highland Park (18 years) A

Nose: Rich, mature oak, top note of aromatic smoke

Palate: Rich, full flavour; honey with peat

Finish: Soft, round and long

Buffalo Trace J

Nose: Outstanding aroma, kicked off by a spicy prickle. Satisfyingly deep, gentle vanilla-ed and molassed with even a sprig of sweet mint

Palate: A rip-roaring waxy sweetness checked by a big build up of vanilla-rich oak. Corn is chewy and rye offers a rich textured background

Finish: Dries at last as the oak takes command, but rye offers extra depth and a layer of bitterness as does a lingering liquorice.

Knob Creek (9 years) C

Nose: Pears, soft rye, saltiness and honey

Palate: A strong play of gentle spice, oakiness, followed by generous amounts of toffee

Finish: Dry, slightly oily finish. Chocolate toffee and vanilla

Sazerac (18 years) A

Nose: Confident and clean with hard grainy edge mixed with cherry and blackberries

Palate: Full effect of rye with a softness. Fruity and flavoursome

Finish: Intensity of rye and oak against spices and fruit

Finish: Vanilla, sharp malt and flinty grain
